## **BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

Cornelius L. Conover (1801-1877) resided in Middletown, New Jersey. He was married to Rachel Winter (d. 1861) and later, Lucy Shepherd (b. 1810). In 1840, both Cornelius and Ruliff (also spelled Ruleph) Conover became administrators of the estate of William Conover, a relative who died intestate.
